

You can also visit a prehistoric cave and admire how people lived in the area 130,000 years ago.

Then, explore the town of Kalambaka and learn about local society and how it has developed under the shade of the Great Rocks. If you want to take a deeper dive into local culture choose between a visit to the Greek Education Museum, a Greek language mini-course, or a workshop on Byzantine art with a local artist. You can even go for a truffle hunt and truffle cooking class in the nearby forest with local expert guides and truffle dogs! You will also have the chance to visit the mushroom mueseum.


This day is dedicated to a road trip in Pindos, the most scenic mountain range of central Greece.
